 - DELIVERED AS COMPUTER BASED EXAMINATIONS (CBE) AND AUTO-MARKED



- CONSTRUCTED RESPONSE (CR) & 🎤
 - CONSTRUCTED RESPONSE QUESTIONS REQUIRE THE STUDENT TO CREATE 'CONSTRUCT' A
 RESPONSE TO THE QUESTION, SUCH AS AN ESSAY EITHER BY TYPING OR WRITING THEIR
 RESPONSE.
